Meeting Minutes

The meeting commenced with a prayer led by Ms R. Jegana, the IQAC member. The Chairperson of IQAC, Dr C. Emmy Prema, started the deliberations with a warm welcome note, appreciated all the stakeholders for being accredited with NAAC 'A' Grade, and informed them that the suggestions provided by the NAAC Peer Team will be shared for further action.

Er T. Isan, Senior Administrative Officer, also appreciated all the stakeholders for their full support in the remarkable achievement of NAAC 'A' Grade and insisted on regular maintenance of all documents. Following this, the IQAC Coordinator, Dr S. A. Praylin Selva Blessy, continued the proceedings per the agenda.

Item 1: Action Taken Report

The IQAC Coordinator elaborated on the action taken report on the minutes of the First meeting for the AY 2024-25.

The actions performed on the previous meeting minutes were:

a) Review of NAAC Peer Team Visit

i. Organizing additional Skill Development and Placement Training Programme

The IQAC Coordinator reported that six career guidance programmes were conducted for final-year students this semester, and more programmes will be planned for the betterment of students.

ii. Increasing PhD Registrations among Faculty Members

The IQAC Coordinator reported that five faculty members have completed the PhD registration selection process at Anna University this semester.

Item 2: Project/Internship for Final-Year Students

The IQAC Coordinator said the current final-year students are the first batch under the R2021 regulation. As per this regulation, students in their final semester can undertake a project or an internship, and the criteria for both were outlined.

Er S. Shijilin Prem Shirold, an IQAC member, suggested that Civil Engineering students would benefit more from undertaking a project and then an internship.

Er Japdrew S, an IQAC member, suggested that students could be permitted to pursue internships as they gain valuable practical experience from industries. Dr X.Roshan Xavier, an IQAC member, also agreed with this suggestion.

Dr R. Christal Jebi, an IQAC member, proposed that students be permitted to undertake both projects and internships. She also insisted that students should complete their internships in reputable companies to gain the maximum benefit.

The Chairperson stated that the students must obtain permission from their respective Heads of Departments and provide the details of the companies where they wish to undertake an internship.

Er T. Isan, Senior Administrative Officer, suggested making a final decision after discussing it with the students.

Item 3: Annual Day and Sports Day celebrations

The IQAC Coordinator stated that the Annual and sports day celebrations would be planned, including forming relevant committees.

Dr S. Jerald Jeba Kumar, the Special Invitee, suggested conducting the Annual Day and Sports Day after the completion of the University Exams.

Item 4: Academic Calendar Preparation

The IQAC Coordinator deliberated on preparing the AY 2024-25 (even semester) academic calendar.

The Chairperson insisted that the Department calendar must be prepared in line with the college academic calendar.

Item 5: Departmental Action Plan for AY 2024-25 (Even Semester)

The IQAC Coordinator reminded the Heads of Departments to submit the departmental action plan for the upcoming semester, including workshops, guest lectures, symposiums/conferences, value-added courses and other activities.

Item 6: Any other issues with the approval of the Chair

The Chairperson informed that as NAAC accredits the institution, AQAR has to be submitted for every academic year, starting with AY 2024-25.

Dr X. Roshan Xavier, an IQAC member, suggested the revision of Institutional Distinctiveness and Best Practices.

The Chairperson opened a discussion for suggestions regarding Institutional Distinctiveness and Best Practices.

Er Japdrew S, an IQAC member, suggested submitting Best Practices from each department from which an appropriate one would be selected.
